

Photography Club of Quail Creek Monthly Photo Contest Detail

The goal of our monthly contest is to have fun with photography, be creative, and experiment with your camera, learning new technical and compositional skills.

- The PCQC Photo Contest is a monthly contest open to current members of the club.
- Eleven months have a theme with the December contest being Open, no theme.
- Photos submitted must be less than 13 months old.
- Entries should be named, sized to 18x12 and a resolution of at least 120dpi.
- Submit up to 3 images to pcqccontest@gmail.com
- Global adjustments to the submission such as brightness, contrast, color can be made along with any cropping desired. Images **must be as taken** with no local adjustments, content removal or additions, or other Photoshop type image manipulation.
- Each club member is allowed to submit up to 3 photos per contest.
- We have a panel of up to 5 judges in various parts of the country, most of which are professional photographers.
- The winning photo each month is printed to approximately 16" X 20" and displayed in the Quail Creek Madera Clubhouse for a month. The image is then displayed in the club display case in the Quail Creek Creative Arts and Technology Center for a month and then given to the winning member.
- Each month an article is printed in the Quail Crossing newspaper showing the top 3 photos for the month and a short description about each one such as where it was taken and the technical details.
- Starting with the 2022 contest year, we will add a "Photo of the Year" contest. Each of the 12 first place photos from the year will be judged and the winner will be printed and displayed along with the winner's name placed on a plaque in our display case at the CATC building.
